Set up in 1999, MERCU has 15 centres comprising one kindergarten, three childcare centres, five student care centres, four learning centres that offer academic and enrichment programmes for students and two private schools offering preparatory courses for GCE 'N' and 'O' Levels. MERCU serves close to 2,000 customers monthly and will continue to provide high-quality programmes and services to all its customers.

MERCU also provides customised programmes for its corporate clients, notably the government schools and learning institutions.
