New Directors Elected to the AMP Board at its 26th Annual General Meeting

2. Mr Hazni Aris Hazam Aris, 40, is a Business Development Manager at TokioMarine Life and is also currently serving as President of Young AMP, the youth wing of AMP. Dr Hishamuddin Badaruddin, 46, is a Deputy Director in the Ministry of Health and is presently a Director of MERCU Learning Point, an AMP subsidiary.
